THE CHILDREN'S WEEK

Class 1 – This week in Class 1 we have read a story called the Sand Horse. We tried to remember as much of the story as we could over the week. We also looked at where the story was set on a big map. In Maths we have been practicing out addition and subtraction counting on and back from numbers up to 20. We have also started practicing for Sports Day, trying out the Football Dribble and the Bean Bag Relay as well as practicing out throwing skills.

Class 2 – The children in Class 2 have all come back excited to talk about what they did over half term and full of energy. In English we have started to think about traditional tales, relating it to our topic on Australia and looking at traditional Australian tales as told by the Aboriginal tribes. In our topic we have discussed and made decisions about whether we would climb Uluru and why. We had fun in science closely looking at different fruits and vegetables (the classroom was a rather smelly mix of onion, lemon, banana, cucumber and other interesting aromas!). We have gone back to basics in maths, exploring and reasoning about place value.

Class 3 – The children thought a lot about their own learning this week and wrote their comments for their upcoming school reports. We also had our final rugby session with the Exeter Chiefs and finished with a 4 nation tournament. In maths we looked at tenths and hundreds, explored them in detail and how to write them as fractions and decimals. **Please can all children bring in empty yoghurt pots on Monday to make some string telephones in science to help us explore sound.**

Class 4 – This week in class 4 we have looked at place value and venn diagrams in maths. In English we have written our own poems using metaphors. This year, Class 4 are running the Young Entrepreneur project again. The children are given a small budget and in groups, have to come up with a business plan, cost the materials and then make the product. The products will then be sold to the rest of the school.

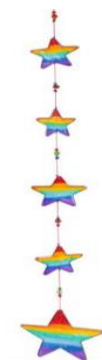
Values Certificates & Learning Behaviour Certificates:
