THE CHILDREN'S WEEK

Class 1 – This week in Class 1 we have been looking at rhyming poetry about dinosaurs. We were able to find the rhyming words in the poems and think of some rhyming words of our own. In Maths we learned about repeating patterns and that you can find them everywhere, we even played clapping games, spotting where the claps repeated. We also created dinosaur facts sheets for our favourite dinosaurs.

Class 2 – This week in Class 2 the children had fun in English following instructions to make paper aeroplanes, then made some insightful points when evaluating the instructions. In maths they have continued with fractions of amounts and numbers. We all got rather messy making models of water creatures out of clay (the less said about the state of the classroom, the better!). We all had an enjoyable afternoon on Thursday with our Marble Jar Treat. It was lovely watching the children sharing the toys they had brought in and generally relaxing and playing together.

Class 3 – We planned, wrote and edited a 500 word story in English. In maths we looked at how to use a grid to answer different types of multiplication questions. We researched different chocolate labels and ingredients and discussed the target audience for different bars. We enjoyed our tennis taster and I hope the children are inspired to try out the tennis at Seaton Tennis Club. In science we looked at our teeth and what causes tooth decay and how we can protect our teeth.

Class 4 – This week in class 4 we had our last swimming session which was a fun floats session. In maths we have been working on rotation, degrees and reflection. In English we have been writing our diary entries on Wolf Brother.
