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## THE CHILDREN'S WEEK

**Class 1** - This week in Class 1 we have looked at the people that care for us, thinking about all the things that they do. The reception children have been exploring the classroom and sharing what they have found with old and new friends. We are looking forward to next week when everyone will be in for the afternoons.
